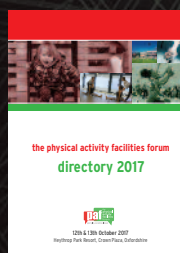

- Sport England is investing £250m to combat inactivity from 2017- 2021.
- The UK's private and public health and fitness sector is valued at an estimated £7.7bn for 2016.
- Sport in England generates a social value of more than £44bn. For every £1 spent on participating in sport in England, £1.91 worth of benefit is generated in society.
- The total cost to the UK economy of physical inactivity is predicted to be around £20bn annually, with 37,000 deaths occurring as a result of people being inactive. People are becoming more active however; the latest figures from the Active People Survey (December 2016) show 15.97 million people over the age of 16 are now playing sport/using the gym weekly. That's up 229,400 from 12 months ago.
